What is a GMO?

Genetically modified organism (GMO) or Genetic engineering (GE) is a plant or meat product that has had its DNA artificially altered in a laboratory by genes from other plants, animals, viruses, or bacteria in order to produce foreign compounds in that food. This type of genetic alteration is not found in nature and has unknown consequenses.

GMOs are linked to health problems.

Animal studies have linked GMOs to allergies, cancers, immune system disorders, and infertility. Recently, a new viral gene (called Gene VI) associated with GMOs has been discovered that may make us susceptible to viral infections, cancer and other diseases. And a recent long-term animal study showed that the ingestion of GMO corn and RoundUp caused massive tumors, organ damage, and early death of rats.

GMOs put the health of our land at risk.

Their use has triggered a rise in the use of pesticides and led to superweeds requiring stronger, more dangerous chemicals.

GMOs hurt farmers' freedom.

Pesticide corporations are working to reduce seed choices available to farmers and force reliance on GM seeds. They also sue farmers whose fields are contaminated by unwanted GMOs. Billions of dollars of US taxpayers' money is used to subsidize genetically engineered crops.

The first ever GMO animal is about to be approved for our dinner plates.

The FDA has given the green light to GMO Salmon that has been genetically engineered so that it grows more than twice its normal size.

Who doesn't support our right to know what is in our food?

Pesticide companies that make genetically engineered food such as *Monsanto*, *DuPont*, *Bayer*, and *DOW*. Junk food companies like *Pepsi*, *Coca-Cola*, *Kellogg's*, and *Hershey's*, also don't want us to know. These companies spent \$46 million dollars to defeat Prop 37!

What happened to Prop 37?

Despite being outspent nearly 6 to 1 and the opposition's campaign of dirty tricks and barrage of misleading TV ads, we nearly won: **YES – 48.6% to NO – 51.4%.** After taking on some of the most powerful corporations on the planet, we lost by a mere 353,657 votes.

- The opposition used tactics such as:
 - Fake Voter Guides
 - Newspapers mislead against Prop37
 - \$1 million per day on commercials
- Deceptive advertisements
- The Farm Bureau to mislead farmers
- "Experts" with conflicts of interest

Thirty-seven states have joined together in a coalition to actively work on getting labeling in their states.

Washington State is attempting a ballot initiative this year. Big Food is meeting with the FDA to talk about national labeling.
